Let Nasikia Camps Take You There

Nasikia Camps are an intimate collection of mobile and semi-permanent camps in the prime wildlife viewing areas of Tanzania's northern safari circuit where guests can experience the evocative destinations of Tarangire, the Serengeti plains, and the Mara River.

Nasikia Camps, and its tour operator arm Maasai Wanderings, were started by Tanzanian Naseeb "Nas" Mfinanga, and his Australian born wife Donna Duggan, with the aim of sharing their own intimate and authentic experience of their home country with visitors from around the world. Tragically, Nas passed away last year, but Donna and the Nasikia Camps family continue to welcome visitors in his honour.

One of the most famed in the collection, Kaskaz Mara Camp, sits in the far northern plains of the Serengeti, a remote and wildlife-filled pocket of the savannah. A fire-side Gin and Tonic never goes down badly at Kaskaz Mara.

The camp offers ten tents designed to merge with the ecosystem, with clear vistas of the wilderness ahead. The camp is unfenced which means that the wildlife comes

and goes as they will, giving visitors the thrill of a silver screen worthy safari from the comfort of their arm chair or spacious bed.

Kaskaz Mara offer guests the opportunity to get closer with the wilderness and its inhabitants with a guided walk, accompanied by an armed walked guide (these guides have never had to use their weapons, but better safe than sorry). Guests will be able to follow animal tracks, hear the crunch of footsteps underfoot and smell the scents of the savannah in the gentle breeze.

Almost as numerous as the stars, are the possibilities for amazing wildlife encounters in this rough, unspoilt part of the Serengeti, far removed from the park's busy transit areas. It teems with prides of lion, roaming cheetah, leopard, and large packs of hyena. Here, the Acacia woodland borders the great savannah, thereby also attracting large groups of herbivores, including elephant, giraffe, zebra, warthog and more, making this the ideal location to experience everything the magical Serengeti has to offer.



Coming Soon: Mandhari Lodge

The latest addition to Nasikia Camps, Mandhari Lodge is due to open on the 1st of February 2019. Situated high on the Manyara Escarpment, it boasts a bird's eye view of the great expanse from Lake Natron to the Mondulli Mountains and across Lake Manyara. The lodge offers nine dramatic, glass-fronted standard suites; one honeymoon suite; one cosy family suite, and the incredible four-bedroomed Nasikia Villa with its own private plunge pool. Visitors can look forward to game drives in the Tarangire National Park, the Lake Manyara National Park and Ngorongoro Crater, as well as the traditional spa treatments, hiking, Swihili cooking lessons, and more.
